



Summer Maintenance Staff

The Summer Maintenance Staff plays a key role in maintaining a safe, efficient operation and appearance of our site; with the wellbeing of our campers, volunteers, staff and visitors our paramount objective.

Position Specific Responsibilities Include

- Recognizing the needs of Ooch campers and enabling a vision for the overall operation and appearance of the site
- Performing maintenance and grounds-keeping duties to ensure a functional, healthy and attractive environment
- Ensuring tools, vehicles and equipment are maintained
- Organizing Maintenance shop and storage areas
- Removing and transporting waste and recycling to pick-up points
- Identifying and making repairs, performing building and site maintenance tasks as required
- Supporting housekeepers as required
- Attending /actively participating in staff training; and compliance with workplace safety protocols.
- Demonstrating a positive and supportive attitude toward camp residents

Qualifications

- Ability to take initiative and adapt to changing priorities
- Ability to work on a team and independently
- Ability to exercise sound judgment in setting and carrying out daily tasks
- Ability to take direction through constructive criticism and direct feedback
- Comfortable performing physically demanding tasks
- Good understanding of building, electrical, plumbing and septic systems
- Aptitude for operating camp tools, vehicles and equipment
- Comfortable working in a medically based environment
- Valid driver's license

Advantageous Criteria

- Experience, or an aptitude with, maintenance and grounds-keeping work.
- Experience working in a camp or resort setting
- Experience working in a child-centred environment. You need to be comfortable around kids.
- Standard First Aid with CPR-C and AED qualification

Dates

The contract runs from June 10th to September 3rd.

Remuneration and Room & Board

Remuneration is \$ \$17.50 per hour. If required, room and board are available at a modest cost from June 16th to September 3rd only.

Particular Working Conditions

In consideration of the population Ooch serves, the incumbent is a non-smoker. Occasional work during evenings, weekends and statutory holidays will be required.

Physical Requirements

The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions require a variety of physical actions, including: walking, lifting, carrying, reaching, pushing and pulling; bending, stooping, kneeling, crouching, sitting and crawling; hammering, torquing, painting, shoveling, sweeping and wiping; and significant fine finger dexterity.

The minimum physical requirements for this position include the ability to:

- Work at extension-ladder height
- Lift 30kg
- Use common maintenance and grounds-keeping tools, vehicles and equipment
- Use commercial maintenance and grounds-keeping products
- Work in varying indoor and outdoor environments, including dusty conditions, uneven terrain and changing weather

Equal Employment Opportunity

Camp Oochigeas invites applications from all qualified individuals. Camp Oochigeas is committed to employment equity and diversity in the workplace and welcomes applications from women, visible minorities, indigenous people, persons with disabilities, and persons of any sexual orientation or gender identity.
