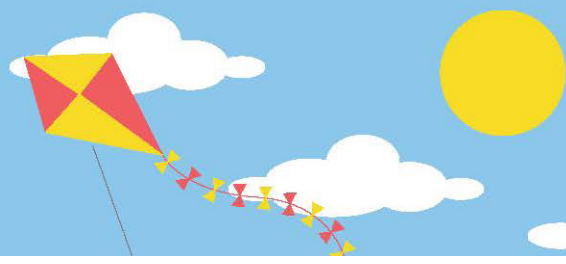

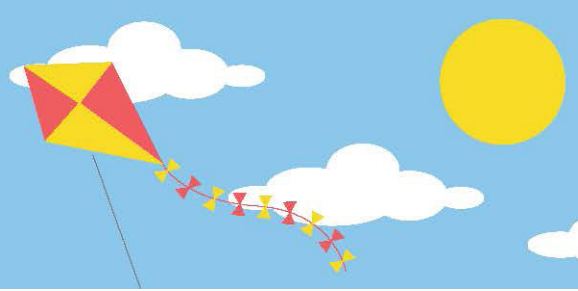
#### Camp Kitchen
